With the current pandemic Wainfleet Township Public Library is required to keep its building closed to members of the community. However, the Wainfleet Township Public Library is still virtually open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, offering a stunning array of services and resources for people of all ages here in the Wainfleet community. We would like to remind our patrons to hang on to their borrowed materials until we reopen as the book drop will remain locked and no fines will accrue during the closure.

Wainfleet Township Public Library is doing all sorts of things to help keep the public both informed and entertained during this difficult time. We are now able digitally provide library cards for residents who may not have had one, or who have had theirs expire, so that they can take advantage of some of our e-resources, including e-books, e-audiobooks, e-magazines, and e-learning. For those who might not be familiar or comfortable with using digital resources, Wainfleet Township Public Library has a "virtual desk" monitored by trained library staff from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.
